

Workshop for transcribing, interpreting and editing 19th and 20th century documents

The Project started in January 2020.

It is aimed mainly at students, MA students and PhD students of the Faculty of History and Philosophy, passionate about historical sources.

It is included in the volunteer program developed by Babeş-Bolyai University, participants receive a volunteer certificate.

Volunteers carry out online activities of transcribing, interpreting and editing of modern period documents (19th to 20th century), under the coordination of specialists affiliated to the Institute of Ecclesiastical History "Nicolae Bocuşan".

Purpose:

- cultivating students' passion for the archival document, for the original sources;
- formatting of specific skills and competences: transcribing, interpreting and editing historical documents;
- developing skills and availability in the field of scientific research;
- promoting the opening of new research sites in the field of church history and religious life;
- ensuring the professional progress of the participants through the mentoring work carried out by specialists affiliated with the Institute.

Result:

- improving the professional and scientific activity of students, MA students and PhD students by involving them in the work of transcribing, interpreting and editing historical documents;
- publication of several volumes containing documents transcribed by the students in the Workshop.
